### THE APPRENTICE PREMIERES MAY 31, 8,30PM

1970s New York. Cohn. 

### A DISTURBANCE IN THE FORCE


PREMIERES MAY 7, 8.30PM

## THE MAN WHO DEFINITELY DIDN'T STEAL HOLLYWOOD PREMIERES MAY 14. 8.30PM

When a former waiter turned movie mogul, Giancarlo Parretti, buys the legendary MGM/UA (the studio behind The Wizard of Oz, Gone with the Wind and the Bond franchise) for \$1.3 billion in 1990, everyone hoped this charismatic Italian, with a mysterious mountain of cash to spend, will make the lion roar again. But within weeks, the 17th James Bond movie is put on ice and pay cheques to Dustin Hoffman bounce. Parretti soon faces an FBI investigation for alleged financial irregularities and his ownership of Hollywood's most famous studio spirals out of control. With unprecedented access to MGM insiders, directors, actors, writers and Giancarlo Parretti himself, The Man Who Definitely Didn't Steal Hollywood unpacks one of Hollywood's bigaest scandals blow-by-blow.



## FRANK CAPRA: MR AMERICA PREMIERES MAY 21, 8.30PM


Frank Capra: Mr America tells the story of how Frank Capra, a young immigrant, rose through the ranks of early Hollywood to become one of the great American storytellers, and one of the most influential filmmakers of his generation. His iconic films include It's A Wonderful Life and Mr Smith Goes To Washington offered an inspiring vision of America where ideals win, integrity triumphs and ordinary people have their day.



#### SCALA!!! PREMIERES MAY 28, 8,30PM

In Britain's post-punk Thatcher years, the infamous and legendary Scala cinema showed a diverse range of films, from high art to cult classics, sexploitation, horror, Kung-Fu and LGBTQIA+. Nudging boundaries of convention, it became an inspiration for future famous creatives. With interviews from nearly fifty contributors, previously unseen archive footage and film clips, Scala!!! is an anarchic, uproarious documentary telling the riotous inside story of the cinema. It was finally forced to close for screening A Clockwork Orange, the film that Kubrick had pulled from UK distribution.

PREMIERES MAY 1, 8.30PM



# CATCHING FIRE: THE STORY OF ANITA PALLENEBERG PREMIERES MAY 8. 8.30PM

Anita Pallenberg was at many points in her life a newspaper headline - a "rock 'n' roll goddess", a "voodoo priestess," and an "evil seductress" in the 60's. She was accused of trying to break up The Rolling Stones, among other things. Never-seen-before home movies and family photographs explore her life with The Rolling Stones and tell a bittersweet tale of both triumph and heartbreak. From Barbarella to the Swiss Alps, and the Lower East Side to London. Anita Pallenberg was a creative force ahead of her time.





## RYUICHI SAKAMOTO: OPUS PREMIERES MAY 15, 8.30PM

On 28 March 2023, legendary composer Ryuichi Sakamoto passed away after his struggle against cancer. In the years leading up to his death, Sakamoto could no longer perform live. Single concerts, not to mention sprawling global tours, were too taxing. Despite this, in late 2022, Sakamoto mustered all his energy to leave the world with one final performance: a concert film, featuring just him and his piano.



# MUTINY IN HEAVEN: THE BIRTHDAY PARTY PREMIERES MAY 29, 8.30PM

Mutiny In Heaven is the first fully authorised telling of the history of The Birthday Party, one of underground music's most notorious and influential bands. Narrated exclusively by the original band members, this film delves deep into a band's psyche, chronicling how Nick Cave and his school friends startled audiences with their confrontational performances, primal screams, outlaw gothic horror, and anarchic lifestyle. Featuring never-before-seen personal footage from band members, dynamic animation sequences, and jaw-dropping concert clips, the film provides a sweaty, electrifying front-row seat to one of the most legendary live acts in rock history.
